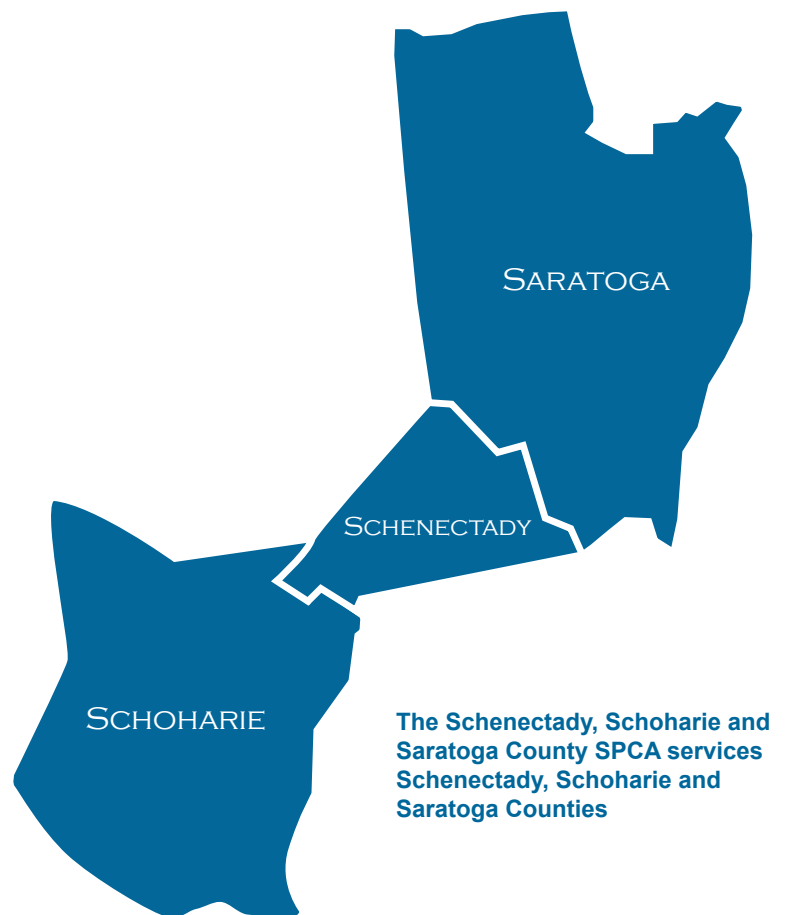

The SPCA is entirely volunteer driven - volunteers constitute 100% of our workforce. This



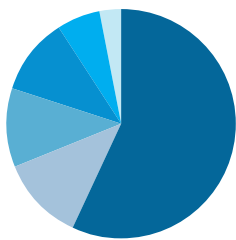
year countless hours were donated, including 989 hours of volunteer law enforcement estimated at \$24,725 in volunteer support.



STATEMENT OF FINANCIAL POSITION

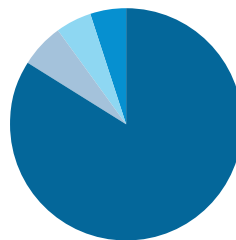

Humane Law Enforcement

The Schenectady, Schoharie and Saratoga County SPCA is currently accepting applications from qualified current or retired police or peace officers. From time to time, we conduct a peace officer academy. Candidates must complete approximately 280 hours of training and minimally commit to eight hours of service per month.
